

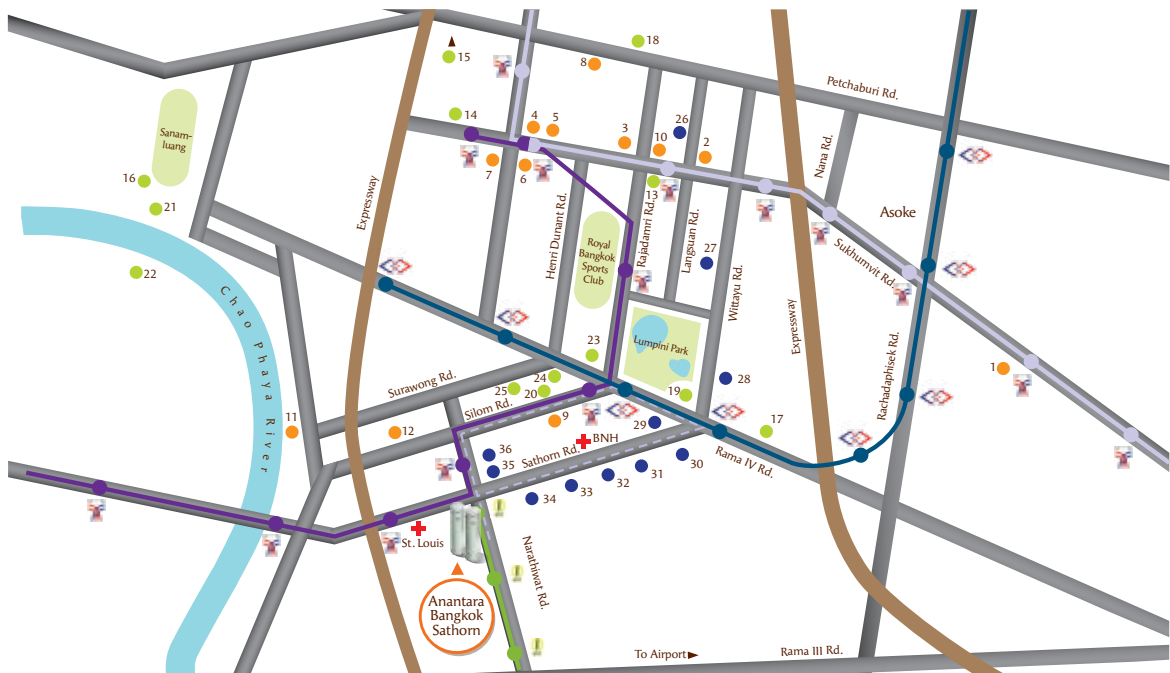

## Bangkok Guide

Bangkok is a city that truly has something for everyone, with a vibrant energy coursing through the streets that provides excitement and intrigue at every corner. Situated in the heart of Bangkok's business and tourist district, Anantara Bangkok Sathorn is well equipped to cater for guests of varying requirements. While its central location provides excellent access across the city, it is also secluded, set to the side of the hustle and bustle of Silom and Sathorn roads.



### City attractions

**Grand Palace:** Bangkok's most famed attraction, built by King Rama I in 1782, is a magnificent visual spectacle of royal Thai culture, encompassing temples, murals and statues that are all lavishly decorated. Anantara Bangkok Sathorn's location beside the river means it is just a short boat ride away.

**Jim Thompson House:** A monument to the Thai silk trade, Jim Thompson House was the personal residence of ex-CIA operative turned silk exporter Jim Thompson. He had the numerous buildings of the residence transported from Ayutthaya and reconstructed in the heart of the city, and they now serve as a museum and restaurant. Access is simple via the BTS Sky Train.

**Siam Square:** The city's hub of both local and international shopping, the area around Siam Square is home to Bangkok's largest shopping malls, selling everything from extreme luxury to high street brands. Siam Square itself is bustling with local fashion shops, including an array of local designer boutiques.

**Wat Arun:** Also known as the 'Temple of Dawn', Wat Arun is one of Southeast Asia's most well recognised monuments, thanks to its ornate carvings and floral pattern spiraling into the sky. Constructed in the first half of the 19th century by King Rama II, it sits on the bank of the Chao Phraya River, making access from Anantara Bangkok Sathorn simple.

**Erawan Shrine:** The famed Erawan Shrine next to Erawan Plaza has visitors from all over the world coming to pay their respects, while beautifully adorned dancers perform for the Hindu god Brahma here.

**Gaysorn Plaza:** Luxurious imported brand names such as Prada, Louis Vuitton and Ferragamo jostle for shoppers' attention amongst excellent local products ranging from clothing and leather accessories to precious gems and jewelry.

**Siam Paragon shopping complex:** One of the city's largest and newest malls, Siam Paragon has something to tempt everyone, from designer brands to high street shops, furniture stores, Bangkok's largest bookshop and an extensive food court serving Thai street style selections.
